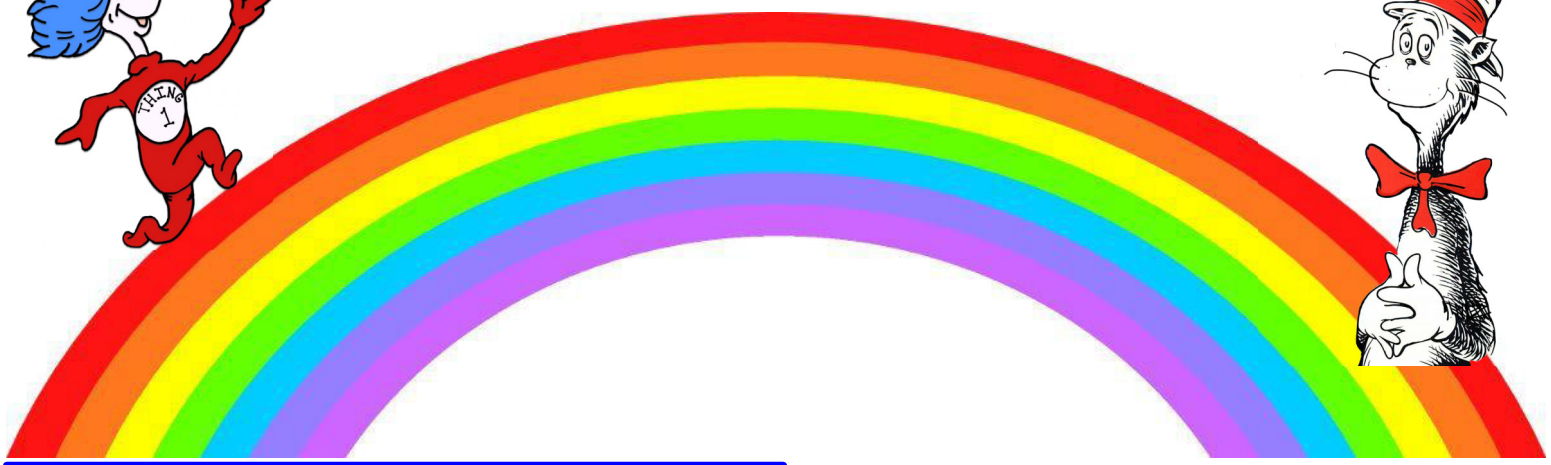
*Please check your child's backpack daily and return any forms that require your signature! Thank you!

Lice Prevention Tips

Here are some tips to help prevent your child from getting lice. Your child can contract lice from anywhere, not just at school.

- Tie hair up in ponytails or braids
- Do not share hats, combs or other items that touch the head
- Do routine head checks at home. Comb out any eggs found in the scalp
- Contact the school and your child's teacher at first site of live lice
